Supply Chain Woman of the Year For female senior executives	Must be actively involved in community services (in personal or professional capacity)	At least 15 years of senior management experience
SME CEO of the Year For CEOs (or equivalent) of Singapore-based SMEs	Must show the success of the company under his or her tutelage [200-word write-up]	At least 5 years in the current position
Supply Chain CEO of the Year For CEOs (or equivalent) of LSPs	Must show the success of the company under his or her tutelage [200-word write-up]	At least 5 years in the current position
Chief Supply Chain Officer of the Year (replace Overall SCP of the Year) For the highest ranking supply chain executives based in Asia Pacific region	Must be actively involved in community services (in personal or professional capacity)	Must be based in the region for at least 10 years
Hall of Fame For the highest ranking regional senior executives in LSPs	Must be a senior supply chain/logistics professional with a distinguished career in the supply chain industry	At least 20 years of experience in senior management
