2 major categories of Awards:

- Individual
- Corporate

All individual awards are conferred by Supply Chain Asia based on our identification and selection process to recognise individuals who have contributed to the growth and success of this industry.

For Corporate Awards:

There are two sub-categories:

- Conferred Awards - Given to companies based on our internal selection process for their success in creating/adopting innovative solutions
- Competing Awards - A list of finalists are selected by Supply Chain Asia Awards committee and put up for final voting to identify a winner

Supply Chain Asia reserves our rights to reject nominations that do not fit into our selection criteria.
